Welcome to the 2021 Granger Farmers Market! We would like to thank all of you for helping to make the 2020 Farmers Market a big success. We could not have done it without your help!

We would like to invite all of you back to participate once more in the 2021 Granger Farmers Market. **We will have our first Market on June 3, 2021.** As before, the Market will be **Thursdays 4 to 7 PM** and we plan to be open when it is windy, smoky, hot, cold, and pleasant. A few items we need producers and sales of: early greens, early crops like asparagus, and transplants for the garden, and melons. The Market Association table is willing to sell items for a small producer to help get a new product in front of customers and is looking for items such as cheese, dried salmon, honey, and toasting bread. If you know of items that we would be able to sell for a producer let us know and we will look into it.

The Board has met to discuss the upcoming year and to review the requirements for COVID requirements during this season. The following are the requirements that need to be in place for this upcoming market:

- The Booth space rental fee will be \$15 a week;
- All vendor booths must be 6' apart, and social distancing, and masks will be required.
- Vendors who sell prepared food will sell it to go. If we are still in Phase 3, we plan to have some limited access for customers to eat on site, following COVID requirements - 5 per table and we hope to have 2 or 3 tables under canopies on the lawn. At this time food sampling is still not allowed.
- All vendors will be required to adhere to COVID Phase requirements as dictated by the governor.
- All canopies **MUST HAVE 25 lb weights** on each of the four legs, to prevent the canopy being blown over by wind and potentially harming others;
- All vendors **MUST have a 1' x 6' sign** with the Vendor name on it so the customers know from whom they are purchasing their product.
- If, the vendor is selling produce and/or products from other farms and/or other merchants, there must be a sign at/near the item being sold with that farm/merchants name on it. This is so the customers know from whom they are purchasing the products.
